Al igual que en otros ámbitos, en la ciencia las mujeres no gozan de las mismas oportunidades que los hombres. Así, los puestos de trabajos más importantes y mejor pagados suelen estar ocupados por hombres. Esta situación es injusta, ya que muchos descubrimiencos fundamentales para el avance de la humanidad fueron realizados por mujeres. Uno de estos casos fue el de Rosalind Franklin.

Siencio uma niña, Rosalind decidió que dedicaria su vida a la ciencia. Y así lo hizo. Fue una estudiante brillante y al acabar sus estudios se marchó a Francia, donde aprendio la técnica que le permitió descubrir la verdadera estructura del ADN. El ADN es una molécula que contiene toda nuestra información genética, es decir, los datos sobre quiénes somos (como un DNI). O dicho de otra manera: el ADN es a la vida lo que las letras a los libros: pequeñas piezas que colocadas en uno u otro lugar dicen cosas diferentes.

Pero por aquel entonces, como ahora, no era fácil ser cientifica (¡Rosalind ni siquiera podía entrar en la sala de profesores por el simple hecho de ser mujer!). Su trabajo fue infravalorado por las instituciones y sus fotografías y descubrimientos fueron empleados por ocros científicos sin su permiso, gracías a lo cual ganaron el Premio Nobel. Solo con el tiempo se descubrió el papel fundamental que había tenido Rosalind a la hora de explicar la esencia de la vida.
