The year is 1950. Tanks are on the border. It looks like the third world war might begin. David is a colonel in the Yugoslav army, a widower with a teenage son. Weary of cruelty, he declines to order the executions of a group of political prisoners, expecting that he'll be shot along with them. However, the general whose life he once saved returns the favor by sending David to a remote mountain village to disarm a band of local smugglers. If David fails, his son might simply disappear.

In the village, David meets Maria, who has sold herself to one of the smugglers, and the two fall in love. The traveling cinema arrives, and the villagers are captivated by a melodramatic Mexican musical. After learning all of the songs, they form a mariachi band, costumed as armed bandoleros...

...but David's commander is en route to the village.

A novelist, columnist, screenwriter, and film producer, Mazzini is the author of twenty-seven books published in nine languages. His short stories can be found in more than a dozen anthologies in seven languages, and in 2011 he was awarded a Pushcart Prize. Two of his screenplays have been produced as feature films, and he has written and directed five short films.

Mazzini possesses a PhD in anthropology and an MA in creative writing for film and television. He lives and works in Ljubljana, Slovenia.

The German Lottery is set in 1950 in a country with a totalitarian regime, where every word can be fatal and everyone is spying on everyone. The story's naively optimistic protagonist, orphaned and injured during the Second World War, has been provided by the government with living quarters and a job as a postman. Determined to carry out his postal duties honorably, he nevertheless is seduced by a beautiful and manipulative married woman and becomes involved with double- and triple-crossing swindlers. The postman's story is lighthearted satire, a study of human nature, and a warning about the power of greed.


